The Competition

The competition is open to First Nations, Métis and Inuit youth under the age of 30 residing in the Prince George area. The logo should represent the meanings and intentions behind Ignite Your Spirit–to spark a sense of strength and connection. The logo represents a resurgence of our culture and history in the youth of our nations, which we are accomplishing by reclaiming our spirit through knowledge and exploration of who we are. We want to highlight the importance of youth voice, youth empowerment and youth engagement.

Please submit your artist bio and logo as separate files. Both files should include your first and last names. Logo submissions should:

- have a short artist biography along with a description of the logo
- be in colour
- be sent in a vector format (e.g., as a .pdf, .ai, or .eps file)
